Background

There's an April 2022 quarterly release of the edit module for clinical diagnostic laboratory services. According to the <u>Medicare Claims Processing Manual, chapter 16, section 120.2</u>, CMS updates the laboratory edit module as necessary to reflect coding updates and substantive changes to the NCDs.

The changes are a result of coding analysis decisions developed under the procedures for maintenance of codes in the negotiated NCDs and biannual updates of the ICD-10-CM codes. This allows us to process laboratory claims subject to 1 of the 23 NCDs (see <u>Medicare NCD</u> <u>Manual, sections 190.12 - 190.34</u>) uniformly throughout the nation. You may access the <u>NCD</u> <u>spreadsheet</u> we include with CR 12575.
