SUBJECT: Revised Illinois-Specific Reporting Requirements and Value Sets Workbook

The purpose of this memorandum is to announce the release of the revised Medicare-Medicaid Capitated Financial Alignment Model Reporting Requirements: Illinois-Specific Reporting Requirements and corresponding Illinois-Specific Value Sets Workbook. These documents provide updated technical specifications and applicable codes for the state-specific measures that Illinois Medicare-Medicaid Plans (MMPs) are required to collect and report under the demonstration. As with prior annual update cycles, the Illinois-Specific Reporting Requirements were revised to update applicable dates and references; however, no other substantive changes were made as compared to the prior version dated February 29, 2024. Note that the Illinois-Specific Value Sets Workbook did include changes; Illinois MMPs should carefully review and incorporate the updated value sets, particularly for measure IL3.4.
