## August 6, 2018 - Reporting Change for Patient Assistance Program (PAP) Data Sharing Agreement (DSA) Records

Effective January 1, 2019, PAP DSA partners must include at least one National Drug Code (NDC) and may include up to five NDCs when submitting records on the PAP Input File. ## November 12, 2015 – Change to Eligibility History Retention Requirements for SPAP's and ADAP's

Effective immediately, State Pharmaceutical Assistance Programs (SPAPs) and AIDS Drug Assistance Programs (ADAPs) should begin retaining eligibility history for all enrollees for 36 months, including for enrollees no longer enrolled, and reporting this information on the monthly eligibility file.
