Notes	
1	MA bid data at the bid-county level (excluding EGWP, SNP, and Part B only coverage) were merged with the enrollment data by bid ID and county and with the ratebook data and county to CBSA crosswalk by county.
2	Note that the bid amounts shown in the data do not necessarily include network coverage across the entire CBSA service area.
3	CBSAs/Rural Areas with less than a maximum of 5 parent organizations in a county or with at least 50% of projected enrollment attributed to a single parent organization in the CBSA are rolled up in what are called non-competitive area totals.

Calculations	
1	<b>Projected Enrollment (excl. EGWP, SNP, Part B only)</b> is the sum of the projected member months in each county that is part of the CBSA divided by 12.
2	<b>Actual MA Enrollment excl. EGWP, SNP, and Part B only (from the Medicare Beneficiary Database)</b> is the sum of the July 2016 MA enrollment in each county that is part of the CBSA.
3	<b>Actual MA Enrollment (from the Medicare Beneficiary Database)</b> is the sum of the July 2016 MA enrollment in each county that is part of the CBSA.
4	<b>Actual FFS Enrollment (from the Medicare Beneficiary Database)</b> is the sum of July 2016 FFS enrollment in each county that is part of the CBSA.
5	<b>Average Bid</b> is the average of the ISAR-adjusted bids for each bid and county included in the CBSA, weighted by the projected member months corresponding to each bid and county.
6	The second lowest ISAR-adjusted bid for a county was selected from all ISAR-adjusted bids in the county. The second lowest ISAR-adjusted bid was set equal to the only bid in counties with only one plan. <b>Average 2nd Lowest Bid</b> is the average of the second-lowest ISAR-adjusted bid for each county in the CBSA, weighted by the projected member months in that county.
7	<b>Average FFS Rate</b> is the average of the 2016 FFS Rate excluding Phase-Out IME for each county in the CBSA, weighted by the projected member months in that county.
