In addition to alpha testing, CMS will conduct beta testing of the CY 2010 PBP/SB. Beta testing is tentatively scheduled for February 2009. Further guidance on this beta testing opportunity will be provided at a later time. Your input is critical to the development of the CY 2010 PBP/SB, and we strongly encourage your participation in all phases of the testing process.
