


There is an increased fire danger risk Friday as wind gusts will be slightly higher than today's along with slightly higher RH values.


There is a slight chance of scattered showers on Friday, with a more widespread chance for showers on Sunday.

There is a slight risk for severe weather Monday into Monday night of next week.


## Increased Fire Danger Risk Friday

**South Central VA / Inland NC:** Sunny. Lows tonight: Mid 40s and mostly clear. Fri Highs: Mid to upper 70s.


**Eastern Shore (MD/VA):** Sunny. Lows tonight: Around 40 and mostly clear. Fri Highs: Upper 60s.

**Tidewater/Peninsula:** Sunny. Lows tonight: Mid 40s and partly cloudy. Fri Highs: Mid 70s.




**Hampton Roads:** Sunny. Lows tonight: Mid 40s and mostly clear. Fri Highs: Mid 70s.

**NE North Carolina:** Sunny. Lows tonight: Mid 40s and mostly clear. Fri Highs: Mid to upper 70s.




