A TORNADO TOUCHED DOWN IN WESTERN SCHENECTADY COUNTY ON THURSDAY
MAY 22ND...AND MOVED SOUTH SOUTHEAST INTO FAR NORTHWESTERN ALBANY
COUNTY. NUMEROUS HOMES...BARNs...VEHICLES...TREES AND WIRES WERE
DAMAGED. FOR MOST OF THE PATH LENGTH THE DAMAGE WAS RATED EF1 OR LESS.
HOWEVER...AT ONE LOCATION ALONG ROUTE 20 IN THE TOWN OF
DUANESBURG...DAMAGE WAS RATED EF3 AS A HOUSE WAS NEARLY COMPLETELY
DESTROYED.
