Severe thunderstorms developed over the eastern Texas panhandle during the mid to late afternoon hours and then developed over the central and western Texas panhandle during the early evening hours. The storms produced large hail and damaging winds with one person sustaining injuries as the eighteen wheeler he was in was blown over on Interstate 4C.
