Local broadcast media relayed report of wind damage to gas station roof at the intersection of U.S. Business Highway 77 and Williams road. Damage was also done to a nearby warehouse. General public had identified a possible funnel cloud in the area at the time of the report. A survey completed by a NWS employee revealed damage consistent with that produced by straight-line winds.

**Scattered to numerous showers and thunderstorms developed along a cold front that moved across deep south Texas. The storms produced straight-line wind damage over portions of Hidalgo and Cameron counties.**
