Damage from Edouard included minor storm tide flooding along portions of the Bolivar Peninsula (\$95,000) and brief flash flooding along portions of Interstate 10 in Chambers County (\$5,000).

Storm tide damage on the Bolivar Peninsula was confined to the Gilchrist area. Ten single family homes experienced flooding up to eighteen inches deep inside the home. Fifteen single family homes and two mobile homes experienced flooding up to six inches deep inside the home.

Interstate 10 was closed in central Chambers County near State Highway 61 due to Edouard's heavy rainfall estimated to be between 3 and 5 inches.
