Three to four inches of rain, with near 6 inches in extreme, over a relatively short period of time caused flood waters to be reported entering a few homes within northern Freeport. There were reports of water in at least 5 homes in Velasco along the 800 block of north Avenue F. There were numerous reports of flooded roadways and standing water in and around the Dow Chemical plant.

Slow moving showers and thunderstorms rotating around weak surface low pressure off the upper Texas coast produce flash flooding in a small area in and around Freeport.
