San Jacinto River overbanks at SH 30. Several feeder roads flooded on I-45. Storm total of 9.29 inches of rain 1 mile north of Huntsville.

A stationary front draped across southeast Texas provided the focus for very heavy rainfall and flooding across the northern part of southeast Texas from the evening of the 2nd through the morning of the 4th. Rainfall totals of 7 to 10 inches were common. The heaviest rainfall and most severe flooding occurred in the Bryan and Kurten areas in Brazos County. The heavy rains busted severe drought conditions that had plagued the area for months.

A powerful squall line associated with a strong cold front swept quickly across southeast Texas on the night of the 5th. This was one of the most significant severe weather events of the year. Wind damage was widespread with heavy rainfall and flash flooding occurring in the northern part of southeast Texas. Two tornadoes were reported, an F1 near Conroe in Montgomery County and an F0 near Shepherd in San Jacinto County.

Harris County Pasadena

Damage to windows and trailers at First Presbyterian Church. Fences and trees knocked over on western edge of adjoining neighborhood with portion of roof torn off Turner Elementary.

Harris County Pasadena

Wind damage near Fairmont Parkway and Country Road. Wall blown off side of strip center with awning blown off gas station. Minor roof damage to a few homes and businesses near the Country Briar subdivision. Numerous trees and fences down in area.

A strong cold front swept across southeast Texas on the 24th, Thanksgiving night. Several small supercell thunderstorms developed and affected mainly Harris and Montgomery counties. Three tornadoes were observed (two F1 and one F0) along with a few reports of wind damage.
