


Outlook Period: Monday 4/7/25 through Friday 4/11/25

OVERVIEW:

Showers and thunderstorms could bring isolated severe weather today. The cold front will move offshore tonight with cooler and drier weather midweek. Another frontal system will bring a chance of showers and thunderstorms Friday.

HAZARDS & IMPACTS	Land: Slight (threat 2 of 5) risk of severe weather today with the primary threat being damaging wind gusts and a few tornadoes possible. Timing: I-95 this afternoon and the coast this evening. Patchy frost possible Tuesday night.
	Marine: A Small Craft Advisory is in effect through tonight. Coastal: High rip current risk for south-facing beaches and Moderate rip current risk elsewhere. High Surf Advisory for Brunswick County beaches today. The rip risk decreases Wednesday. <u>SRF Forecast</u>
