SEAS

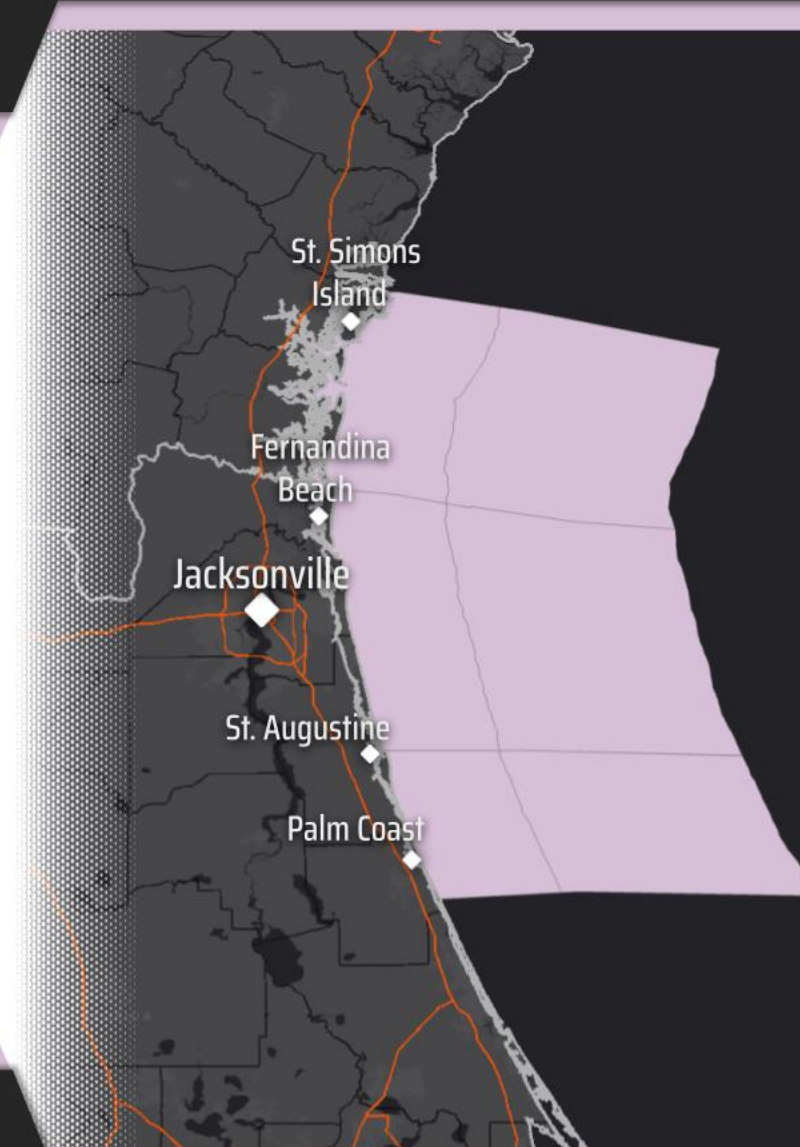
- 5-8 feet
