PARISH EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT REPORTED 130 BOATS IN THE BURAS MARINA WERE DAMAGED WITH 20 REQUIRING MAJOR REPAIR. DAMAGE WAS MOSTLY FROM POINT A LA HACHE SOUTHWARD.
