
# **TOP STORY:**


#### Rainfall in the Past Week






# Upper Level Steering Patterns






#### Surface Weather Map with Fronts













Patchy light rain is seen by radar near Houston and Galveston, stretching out into the Gulf of Mexico.



#### Radar Simulation Tonight into Friday AM









Light rain over Texas moves east this evening and could produce a little sleet or rain in southeast Texas or southwest Louisiana.

## Radar Simulation Tonight into Friday AM








Light freezing rain and sleet will be ending after midnight tonight, with no accumulation expected.

North of the red line, we are not expecting any freezing rain or sleet tonight.

# Weekly Weather Summary



 Patchy light rain could turn to patchy freezing rain and sleet later tonight, primarily along and south of the I-10 corridor. No ice accumulation is expected.

 Temperatures will be below freezing each night through the weekend. A hard freeze (25 F or below) is expected in most of our region from Friday night into Saturday morning.
