

Generally light rainfall amounts with spotty locally higher totals.




Tropical Weather Outlook



Showers and thunderstorms associated with a tropical wave located over northern Guatemala and southeastern Mexico have become a little better organized since yesterday. This system is forecast to emerge into the Bay of Campeche tomorrow, where an area of low pressure could form. After that, additional slow development of this system is possible while it moves northwestward over the southwestern Gulf of Mexico. By Saturday night, the system is expected to move inland over northeastern Mexico. An Air Force Reserve Hurricane Hunter aircraft is scheduled to investigate the system on Friday, if necessary.



Upper Level Steering Patterns




Upper ridge out west and trough of low pressure to the east. Pattern will change very little over the next week.



Surface Weather Map with Fronts




Surface front stalled across the area today. Will lift back to the north tonight.
