#### Tropical Weather Outlook




A disturbance in the western Caribbean has a low 30% chance for development before it moves over mainland Mexico early next week.

Mindy will move east into the Atlantic.


Another disturbance coming off the coast of Africa has a medium 60% chance for development, but it poses no threat to us over the next week.



#### Upper Level Steering Patterns




High pressure is centered over the Four Corners.




#### Surface Weather Map with Fronts






#### 6 AM Weather Observations
