
Cool and dry weather continues through the weekend into next week.


#### Rainfall in the Past Week






## Upper Level Steering Patterns





#### Surface Weather Map with Fronts






#### 6 am Weather Observations




Under cloudy skies, temperatures were in the mid 40s to mid 50s. Winds were out of the north at 10 mph.



#### 2 pm Weather Observations




Under mostly cloudy skies, temperatures were in the 50s to mid 60s. Winds were out of the north at 10 mph.
