A strong upper level low moved north of the region causing an increase in mid level winds over the South Plains and extreme southwestern Panhandle. These strong winds mixed to the ground behind a dryline that moved east off the Caprock Escarpment by mid afternoon. Sustained winds of 40 to 45 mph with gusts to 60 mph occurred. The surface wind was even higher behind a Pacific cold front that moved through the region during the early evening. Widespread blowing dust decreased visibility to less than 1/2 mile at times. The wind also blew down numerous large tree limbs and power lines, snapped numerous power poles, damaged the roofs of several buildings and produced major damage to the roof of a church.

The West Texas Mesonet stations recorded a number of high wind events across the region during the afternoon and evening hours. The measured peak wind gust at each of the stations exceeding high wind criteria follows: 64 mph gust 5 NE Abernathy in Hale County, 60 mph gust 1 NE Amherst in Lamb County, 66 mph gust 6 S Anton in Hockley County, 65 mph gust 2 S Brownfield in Terry County, 62 mph gust 2 NE Dimmitt in Castro County, 67 mph gust 2 NE Floydada in Floyd County, 68 mph gust 2 NE Friona in Parmer County, 67 mph gust 5 SW Graham in Garza County, 62 mph gust 3 N Hart in Castro County, 61 mph gust 3 W Lubbock in Lubbock County, 71 mph gust 4 S Levelland in Hockley County, 66 mph gust 1 NE Morton in Cochran County, 70 mph gust 1 N O'donnell in Lynn County, 71 mph gust 3 N Plains in Yoakum County, 61 mph gust 1 S Plainview in Hale County, 78 mph gust 1 SE Ralls in Crosby County, 69 mph gust Reese Center in Lubbock County, 62 mph gust 7 E Silverton in Briscoe County, 62 mph gust 2 NE Slaton in Lubbock County, 58 mph gust 8 SW Sundown in Hockley County, 65 mph gust 3 NE Tahoka in Lynn County, and a 59 mph gust 2 NE Tulia in Swisher County.
