Rich moisture with dewpoints in the 60s streamed north ahead of a cold front this afternoon. Around 1400 CST, scattered multicell thunderstorms developed from the southwest South Plains northeast through the far southeast Panhandle and moved east into the Rolling Plains through the late evening. Some of these storms produced destructive wind gusts, hail as large as golf ball size, and two instances of flooding from torrential downpours of nearly one half inch in just five minutes. The most destructive storm tracked from northwest of Lamesa to O'Donnell where very large hail decimated large quantities of cotton fields primed for harvest.
