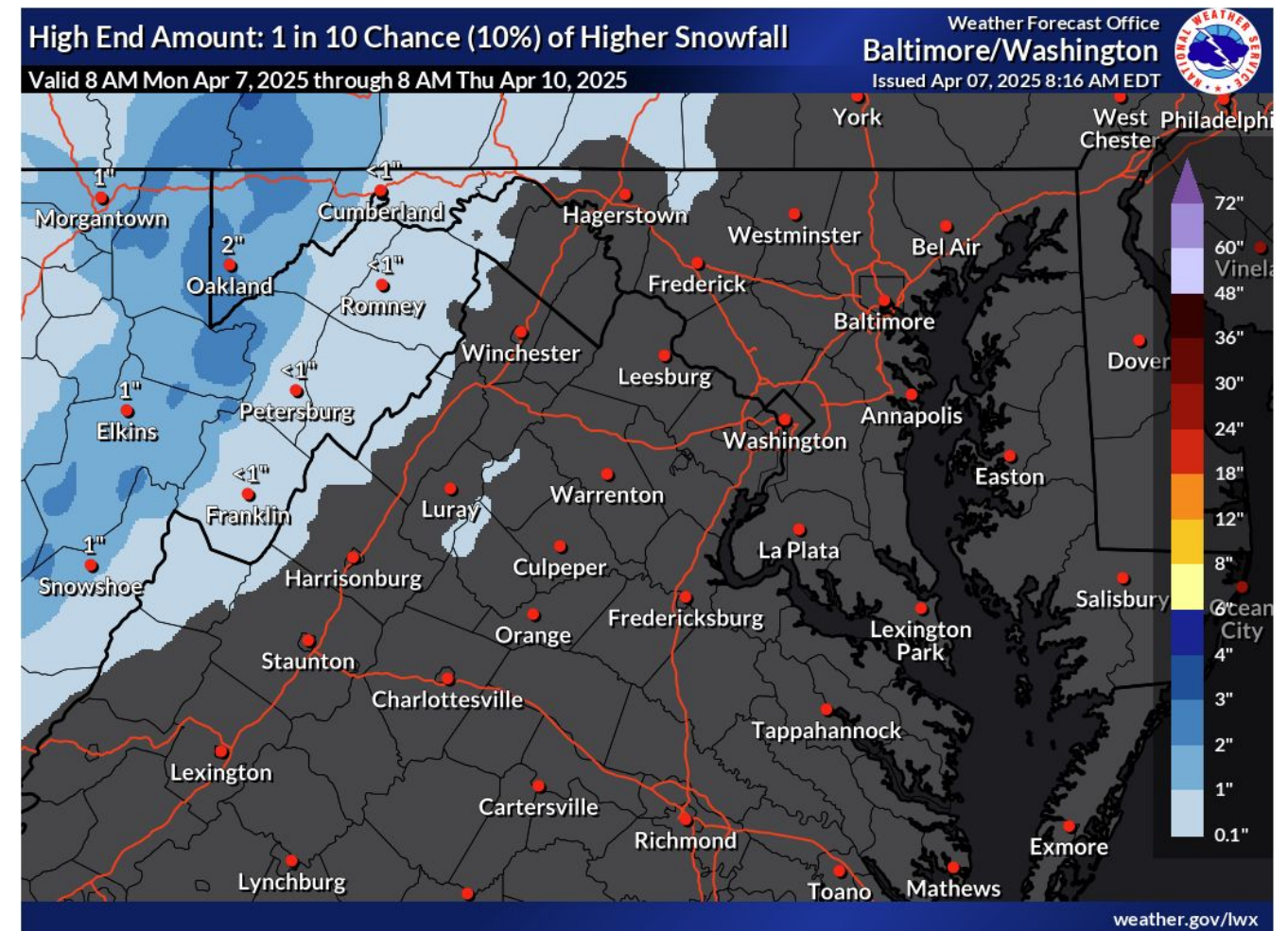
# Mountain Snow

Tonight into Tuesday morning

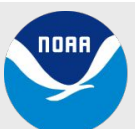
April 7, 2025

  - Snow could accumulate 1 to 3 inches in the mountains & perhaps a coating in the low-lying valleys



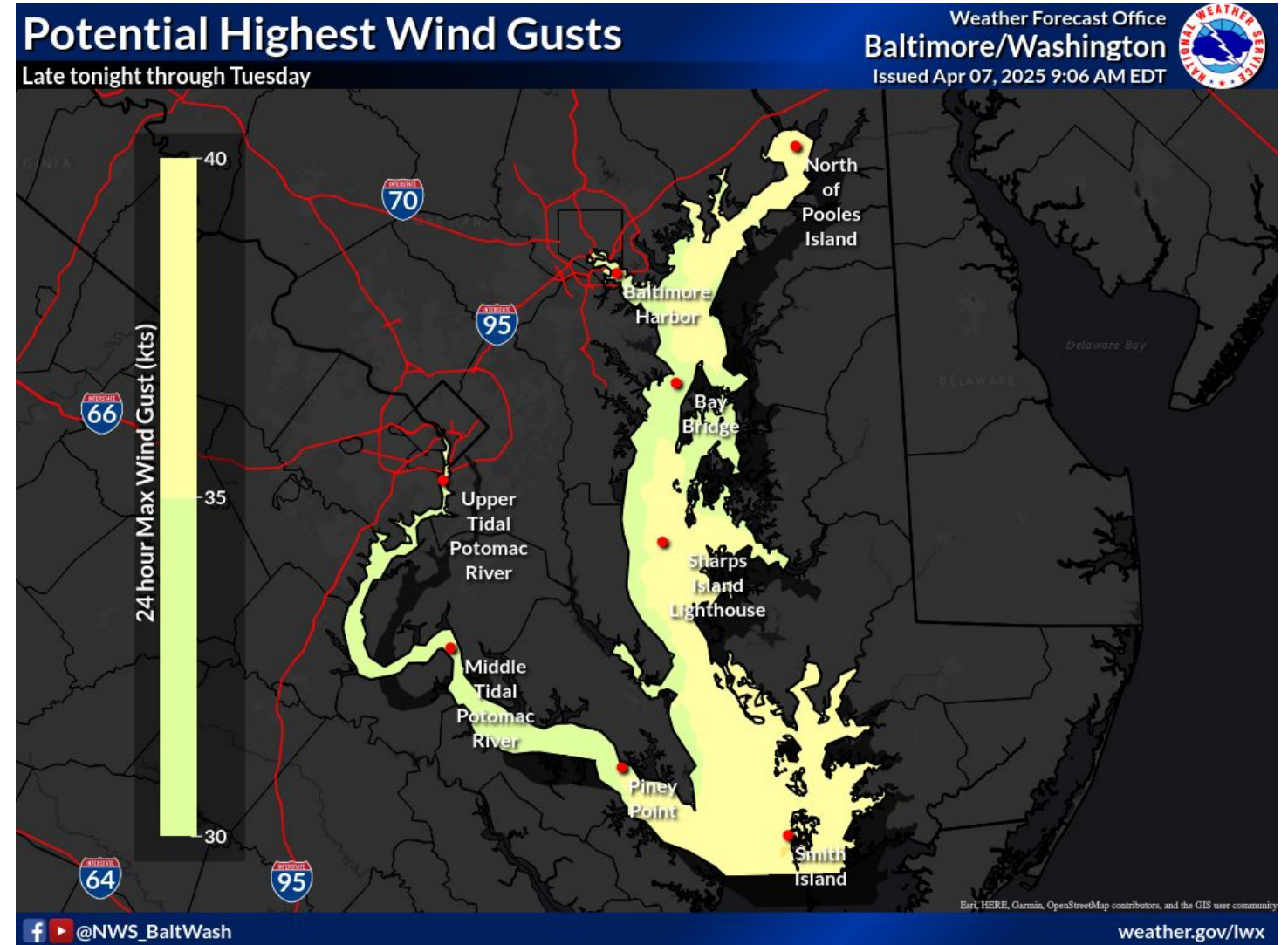
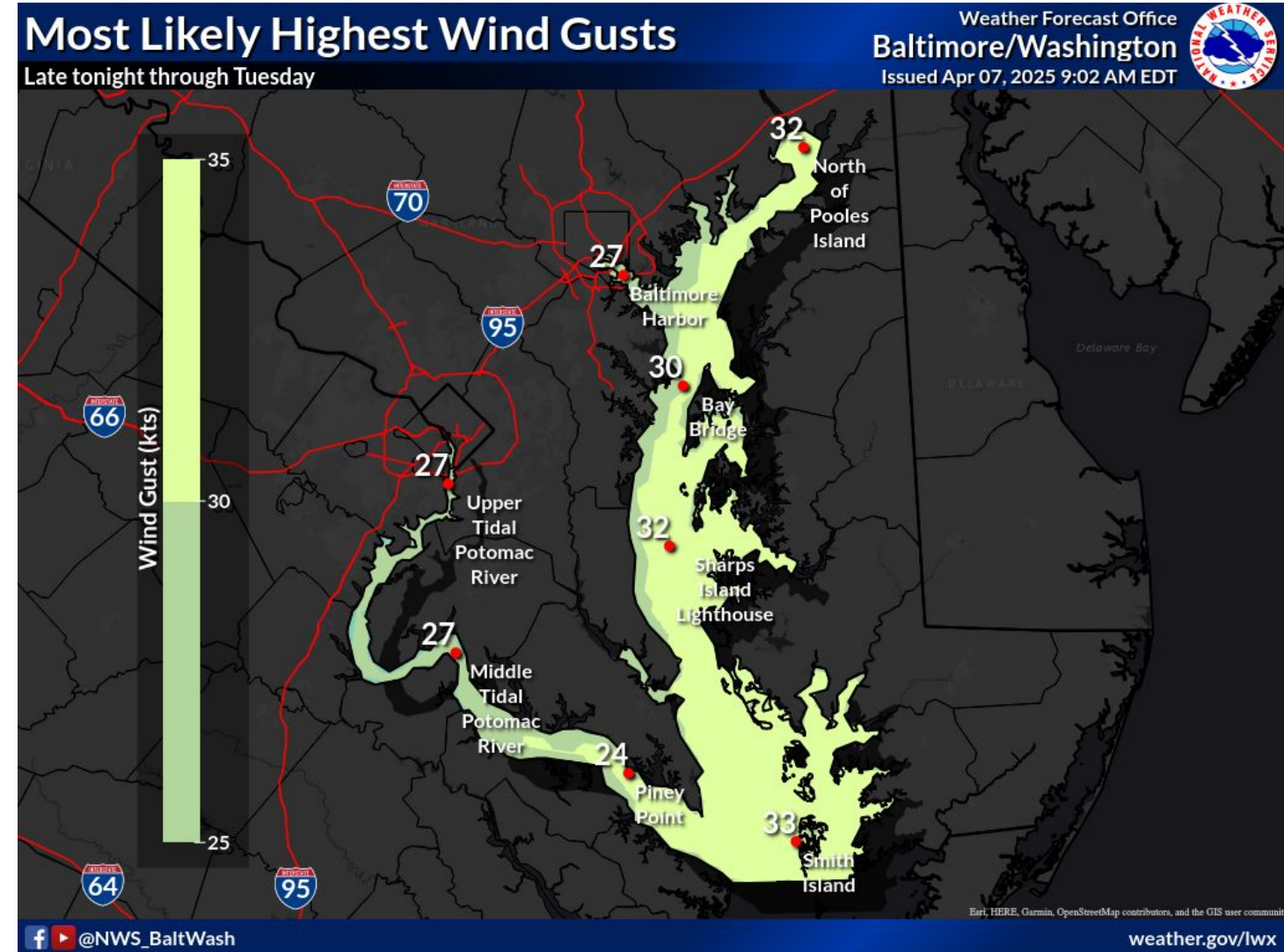




# Gusty Winds Over the Waters

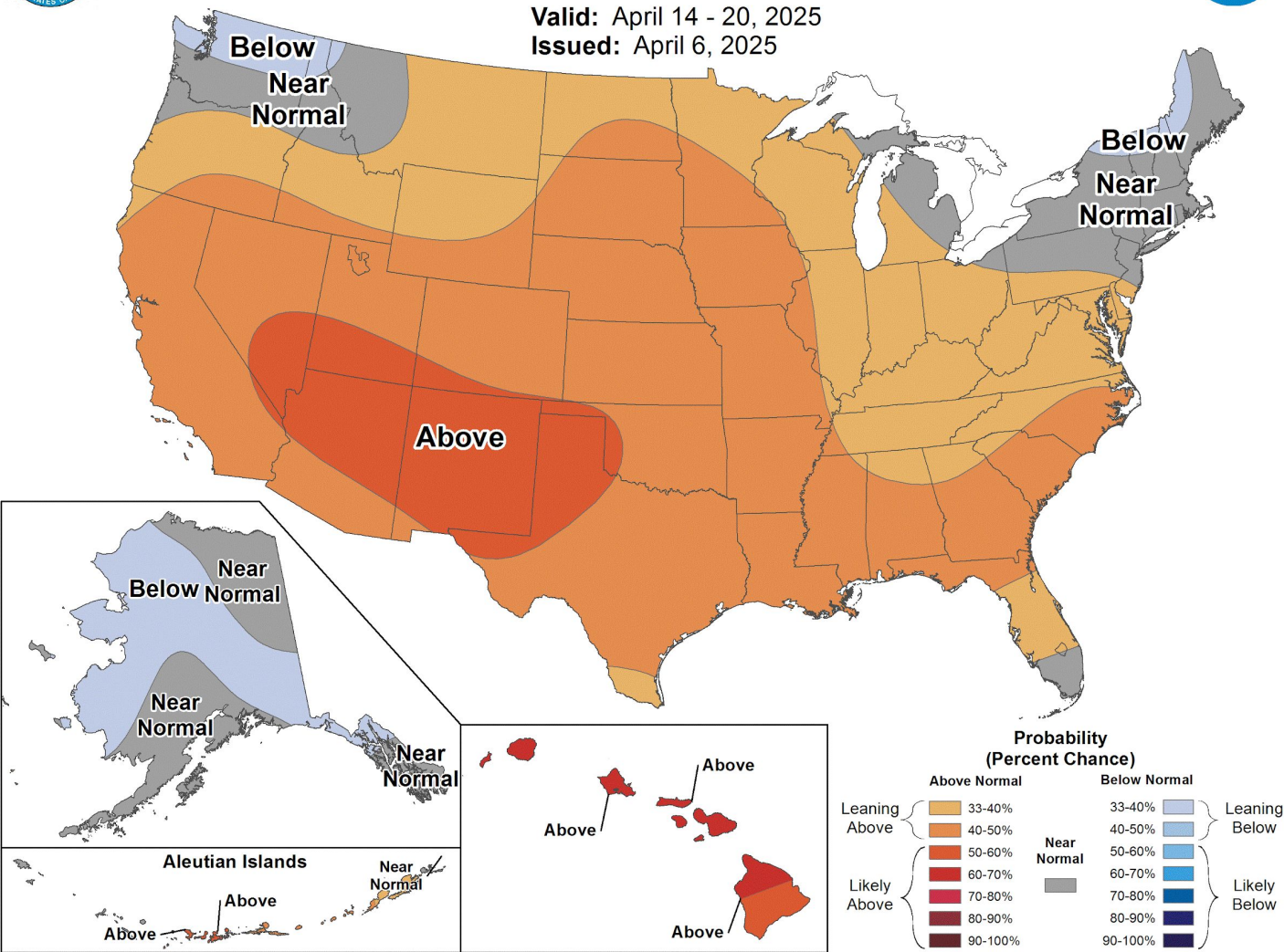

Issued: April 6, 2025



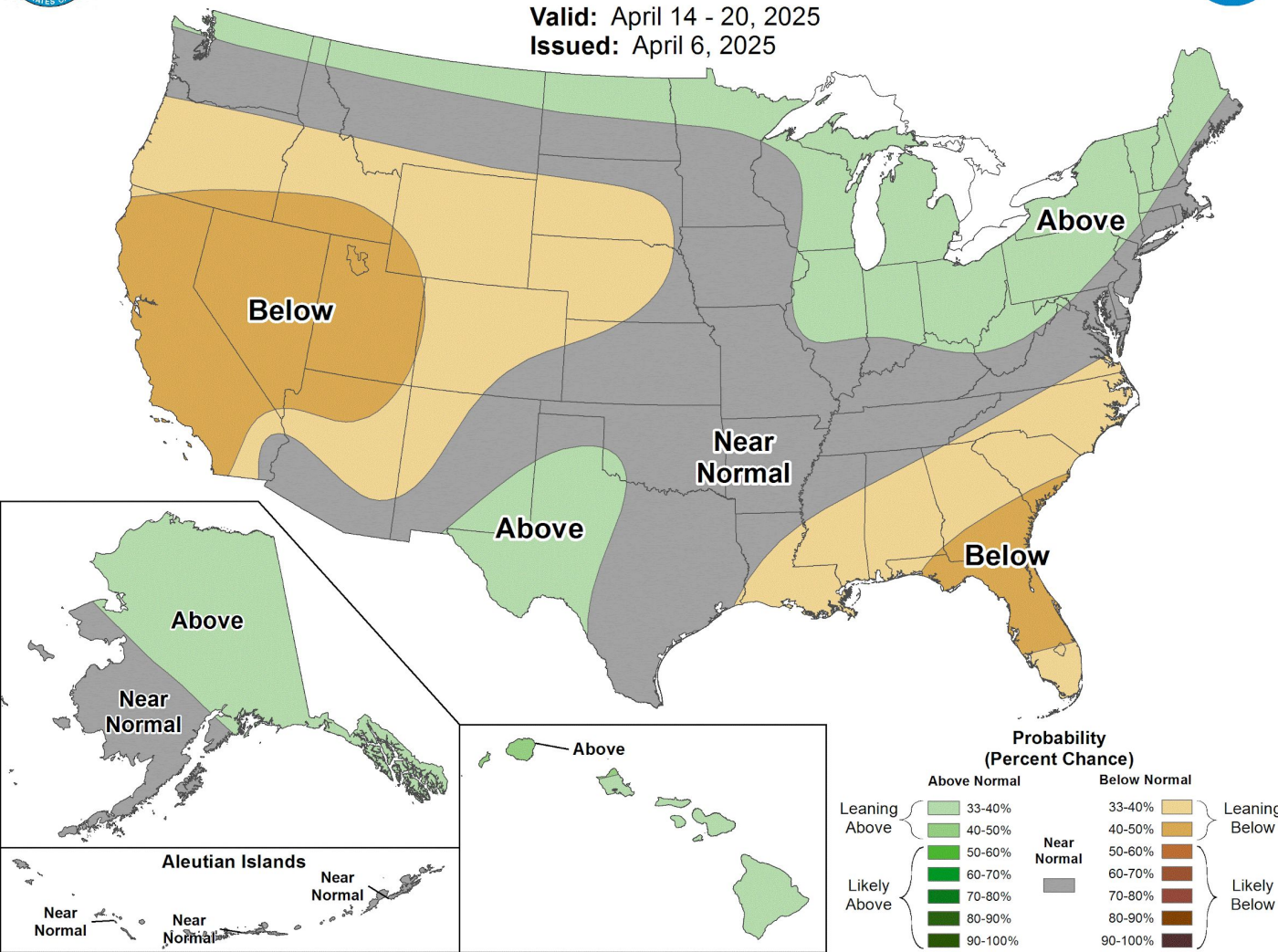
Above Normal Temperatures

Near to Above Normal Precipitation





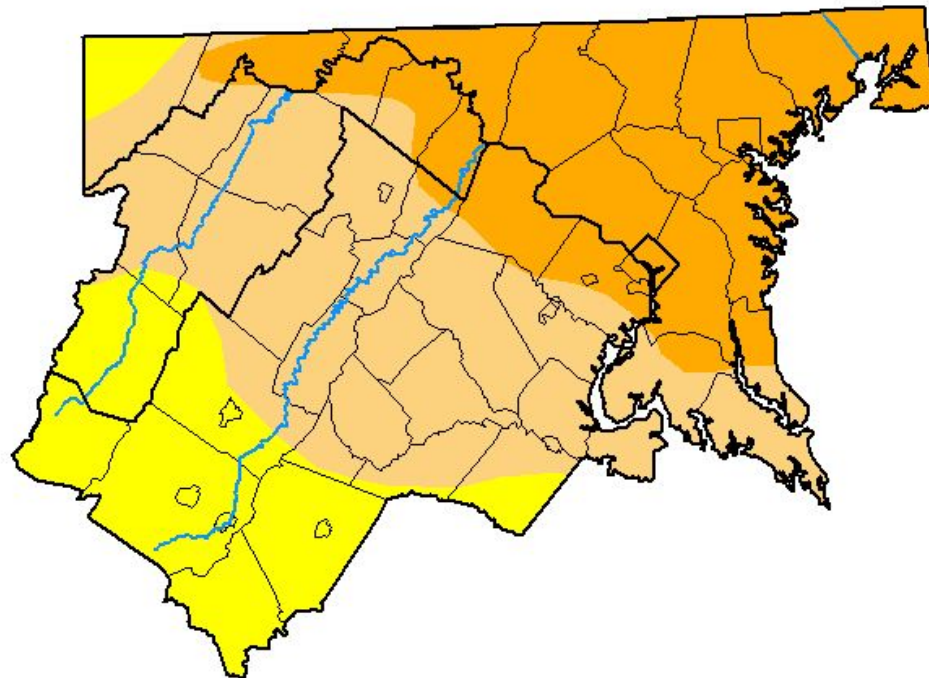

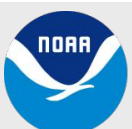
