
No widespread hazardous weather is expected at this time






Mountain Snow

 - Snow accumulation a coating up to one inch tonight.




- Worse Case Scenario
 - Snow could accumulate 1 to 3 inches in the mountains & perhaps a coating in the low-lying valleys






Gusty Winds Over the Waters

Late tonight through Tuesday






Northwest wind gusts around 30 knots most likely.


 A few gale-force gusts around 35 knots possible.

Late tonight through early Tuesday morning






Growing season will start April 11 east of the Allegheny and Potomac Highlands






Cold Temperatures Expected

Late Tuesday night through early Wednesday morning












8-14 Day Outlook; Apr 14-20, 2025

Near to Above Normal Precipitation




