

Regional Climate Summary

June 2018

Above normal temperatures were prevalent this month as many locations experienced their top 10 warmest June. Midland saw 13 days with high temperatures above 100°F & overnight lows only fell below 70°F four times. Despite the warm temperatures, relief arrived in the form of rain. Rainfall amounts were above normal for the first time this year in Midland. Parts of the Permian Basin & Trans-Pecos received 1.00-4.00" with most of the rain falling on the 16th-17 & the 29th-30th. Unfortunately, there were a few occurrences of damage from severe storms on June 3rd in Midland & June 7th in Scurry/Mitchell Counties.
