**[ X ] No flood stages were reached in this HSA for the month above.**

**No river or flash flooding occurred across southwest Texas or in southeast New Mexico during the month. Only light rainfall fell across the HSA, with most locations recording less than one-half inch.**

**Midland International Airport recorded 0.13 inches for the month, which was 0.56 inches below normal. For the year, Midland remains well below normal. Only 4.52 inches has fallen for the year which is still On track for the second driest year on record.**

**Reservoir levels across the HSA and in northern Mexico remain well below conservation levels and the flood threat remains low.**
