August was another wet month across the Midland Hydrologic Service Area with Midland International Airport reporting 3.17 inches of rainfall for the month. The normal for August is 1.77 inches. Out of 31 days, 19 saw rain (and many times heavy rain) somewhere in the Forecast Area.

Two noteworthy incidents

- August 2: Record daily rainfall at Midland International Airport with 2.72 inches reported. This beat the old record of 0.38 inches set in 1962
- August 18: Tropical Storm Erin affected portions of the eastern forecast area causing flash flooding across many areas.
