THE NATIONAL WEATHER SERVICE WILL BEGIN ISSUING A GRAPHICAL FLOOD POTENTIAL OUTLOOK PRODUCT OCTOBER 1 2001. THIS PRODUCT WILL IDENTIFY AREAS ACROSS THE NATION WHERE SIGNIFICANT FLOODING IS EXPECTED OVER THE SUBSEQUENT FIVE DAYS...AND WILL BE ISSUED DAILY AT 1630 COORDINATED UNIVERSAL TIME /UTC/. A GRAPHICAL FLOOD POTENTIAL OUTLOOK COVERING THE LOWER 48 STATES /CONUS/ WILL BE DISSEMINATED OVER THE SATELLITE BROADCAST NETWORK /SBN/...THE FAMILY OF SERVICES /FOS/...THE EMERGENCY MANAGERS WEATHER INFORMATION NETWORK /EMWIN/...AS WELL AS THE INTERNET. A SECOND GRAPHICAL FLOOD POTENTIAL OUTLOOK COVERING ALASKA WILL ALSO BE PRODUCED AND WILL ONLY BE AVAILABLE ON THE INTERNET.

THE INTERNET BASED PRODUCT...LINKED FROM THE HYDROMETEOROLOGICAL PREDICTION CENTER/S WEBSITE AT /USE LOWER CASE/: <u>HTTP://WWW.HPC.NCEP.NOAA.GOV/</u> WILL PROVIDE LINKS TO THE INDIVIDUAL RIVER FORECAST CENTER PRODUCTS USED IN THE PREPARATION OF THE NATIONAL PRODUCT. ADDITIONAL INFORMATION CONCERNING THE POTENTIAL FOR FLOODING WILL BE AVAILABLE ON THE RIVER FORECAST CENTERS AND WEATHER SERVICE FORECAST OFFICE/S WEBSITES.

THE WORLD METEOROLOGICAL ORGANIZATION /WMO/ HEADING FOR THE CONUS GRAPHIC HAS NOT YET BEEN APPROVED. WE WILL SEND AN UPDATED SERVICE CHANGE NOTICE WHEN THE WMO HEADER HAS BEEN ASSIGNED.

SIGNIFICANT FLOODING IS DEFINED AS FLOODING THAT ADVERSELY AFFECTS ROADS...RESIDENTIAL...COMMERCIAL...INDUSTRIAL AND/OR AGRICULTURAL AREAS AND MAY REQUIRE THE EVACUATION OF PEOPLE AND/OR LIVESTOCK. THIS PRODUCT WILL FOCUS ON POTENTIAL FLOODING ON RIVERS AND WILL NOT INCLUDE THE POTENTIAL FOR FLASH FLOODING. THE FLOODING POTENTIAL WILL BE IDENTIFIED AS "POSSIBLE" WHEN THERE IS A 30 TO 50 PERCENT CHANCE OF SIGNIFICANT FLOODING SOMEPLACE WITHIN THE IDENTIFIED AREA. THE POTENTIAL WILL BE IDENTIFIED AS "LIKELY" WHEN THERE IS A GREATER THAN 50 PERCENT CHANCE OF SIGNIFICANT FLOODING SOMEPLACE WITHIN THE IDENTIFIED AREA. THE PRODUCT WILL ALSO DEPICT AREAS WHERE SIGNIFICANT FLOODING IS OCCURRING.

THIS PRODUCT IS INTENDED TO ALERT EMERGENCY MANAGERS AND OTHERS THAT A POTENTIAL FOR RIVER FLOODING EXISTS AND CAN SERVE AS AN ENTRY POINT FOR USERS SEEKING HYDROLOGIC INFORMATION.
