ON WEDNESDAY...JANUARY 14 2004 AT 400 AM CENTRAL STANDARD TIME /CST/...THE
STATE FORECAST PRODUCT /SFP/ FOR TENNESSEE...ISSUED BY THE NATIONAL
WEATHER SERVICE /NWS/ OFFICE IN NASHVILLE...WILL BE CHANGING FROM A
NARRATIVE FORMAT TO A TABULAR FORMAT. THE TABULAR FORMAT WILL INCLUDE
FORECASTS FOR WEST...MIDDLE AND EAST TENNESSEE.

THE FORECAST ELEMENTS IN THE TABULAR STATE FORECAST WILL INCLUDE THE HIGH
AND LOW TEMPERATURE...PREDOMINANT WEATHER...AND PROBABILITY OF
PRECIPITATION. THESE FORECASTS WILL PROJECT OUT TO SEVEN DAYS.

CUSTOMERS WHO WISH TO RECEIVE THE TABULAR STATE FORECASTS FOR TENNESSEE
SHOULD COORDINATE THE INFORMATION PROVIDED IN TABLE 1 WITH THEIR SERVICE
PROVIDERS.
