

Diehlstadt, MO EF-2 Tornado

June 4, 2012

Severe thunderstorms formed over southeast Missouri and far southern Illinois on the evening of June 4. The strongest storm produced large hail of golf ball to baseball size across Scott County, Missouri between 8 and 8:30 p.m. This cell evolved into a supercell and went on to produce an EF-2 tornado in the Diehlstadt area in addition to downburst wind damage. Details of the Diehlstadt tornado and downburst are provided below, along with a few pictures of the storm damage.
