

### High Water Recedes, Next System Thursday

**April 7, 2025** 10:00 AM

Widespread freeze tonight and tomorrow night

#### **Decision Support Briefing**

As of 10 AM April 7, 2025



- Some reaches of the Ohio and some tributaries will continue to run above action stage with some backwater issues
- Reinforcing cold front tonight with light precip (including some light snow!)
- Freeze likely region-wide Tuesday & Wednesday morning
  - Freeze Warning in effect where growing season has been declared open
- Briefly warmer Wednesday ahead of the next system Wednesday night into Thursday
  - Generally light (<.50 inches) precipitation expected
  - Low, but non-zero severe threat contingent on more favorable Thursday afternoon timing




















**Today**

Next chance for rain and thunderstorms arrives with a late week system.






# Flooding

#### **Key Points**


- → Minor flooding continues along portions of the Ohio River and some of its tributaries.
  - Water levels are slowly falling.
- → Some backwater issues may linger into Tuesday.
- → Portions of the Muskingum may approach flood stage again

**Ohio River** 





#### **Muskingum River**









#### **Recent Events**

Several inches of rainfall fell across the region over the last few days with flooding reported across the Middle Ohio Valley into the Southern Coalfields


#### Flood, Wind and Hail reports from the past 72 hours
