

PULL ASIDE • STAY ALIVE

On Oct. 29, 2013, a multiple-fatality crash occurred involving six semi tractor-trailers and 13 other vehicles in the eastbound lanes of Interstate 10 between Phoenix and Tucson. Authorities say low visibility caused by dust was a factor in these chain-reaction collisions.



NEVER DRIVE INTO A DUST STORM!

Dust storms in Arizona can reduce visibility to near ZERO in a matter of seconds!

- Avoid driving into or through a dust storm.
- Check for traffic around your vehicle and slow down.
- Completely exit the roadway if you can; do not stop in travel or emergency lanes.
- Turn off all vehicle lights, including emergency flashers.
- Take your foot off the brake; set the emergency brake.
- Stay in your vehicle with your seat belt buckled.
- Wait for the dust to clear.
