Example #1 – Defined Area Flash Flood Warning. Forecasters at WFO Morristown evaluate the amount and intensity of heavy rainfall over Bradley and McMinn Counties in eastern Tennessee, and after reviewing additional factors such as flash flood guidance, decide to issue a flash flood warning.

FLASH FLOOD WARNING

The National Weather Service in Morristown has issued a

- \* Flash flood warning for...
  Bradley and McMinn Counties in eastern Tennessee
- \* Until 9 pm EDT Sunday
- \* At 6:00 pm National Weather Service radar indicated thunderstorms repeatedly moving over the central and eastern portions of Bradley and McMinn Counties. Rains in excess of 2 inches have already occurred with at least another inch expected.
- \* Areas already reporting flooding include the towns of Cleveland and Fairview.

A flash flood warning means that rapid onset flooding is imminent or has been reported. If flooding is observed, act quickly. Do not stay in areas subject to flooding when water begins rising. Never drive cars, trucks or sport utility vehicles through flooded areas. The water may be too deep to allow for safe passage.
