<u>Example #5 – Upgrade Point-Based Flood Advisory to Point-Based Flood Warning</u>. Heavy rainfall persists longer than expected over the Florida panhandle and the Tallahassee WFO decides that the flood advisory for the Choctawhatchee River at Caryville needs to be upgraded to a flood warning.
